Through the game we will bring the little ones closer to discovering other forms of cultural expression.

8-11 years | The Alhambra of my dreams

Who has not ever imagined an ideal place to live? The Alhambra and its surroundings are the product of the development and evolution of a city over almost 800 years. Going through its streets, spaces, emblematic places and corners, we will discover through the game which parts are essential in a city for its operation and the delight of its inhabitants.

12-14 years | Tall they are and they shone

In the Alhambra, its admired Nasrid palaces are hidden behind a military framework that transmitted to everyone who contemplated them, and still contemplate them today, an image of authority, power and strength. In this experiential experience, the participants will discover how these constructions were built and used through play, thus strengthening learning, acquiring knowledge, using active listening and the exchange of concerns and experiences.

15-17 years | 3, 2, 1,... Broadcasting from the Alhambra

The Alhambra is still alive, it tells us and communicates many stories in countless different ways, it presents itself to us as a sender, receiver, channel and message. We will listen to it in a different way than the traditional one through music, poetry and nature. At the same time, it will be a source of inspiration to create stories and conversations between the participants and the monument, thus generating new voices and new perspectives, through dynamics: radio, podcast...

“Shakespeare in the Park” is back after last year’s success. The show is curated by Paolo Valerio, Director of Teatro Stabile del Friuli Venezia Giulia Il Rossetti in Trieste, and will be staged in a new version with fragments of love, passion, power and jealousy in the Castle and Park of Miramare from 19 to 31 July 2022, at 7.30 pm.

The audience will see how Shakespeare’s words, his characters and the inspiration behind his sonnets perfectly fit into the Park’s romantic lushness and the glimpses of the Castle, where it seems natural to meet Ophelia’s passion, Juliet’s innocence, Romeo’s impetus or Hamlet’s dark soul, as stormy as the waves breaking under the crenellated towers.

On June 26 the [Reggia Express](#) returns, an appointment with the historic train that allows you to directly reach the Royal Palace of Caserta starting from the Napoli Centrale station.

The convoy, consisting of carriages of the Centoporte and Corbellini type, will leave at 10 am from the central station of Naples directed to Caserta, arriving at 10.40 am. The return train will depart from Caserta station at 5pm, arriving in Naples at 5.30pm.

Also, this year the Royal Palace of Caserta, a museum institute of the Ministry of Culture, dedicated a special “Royal Palace Express” ticket at a reduced rate to the initiative only for travelers on the historic train. Holders of the round-trip ticket (Naples / Caserta) will be able to take advantage of a discounted ticket, for the date of June 26, at a cost of 10 euros (plus one euro for online purchase), to visit the complex vanvitelliano (Royal Apartments, Royal Park and English Garden).

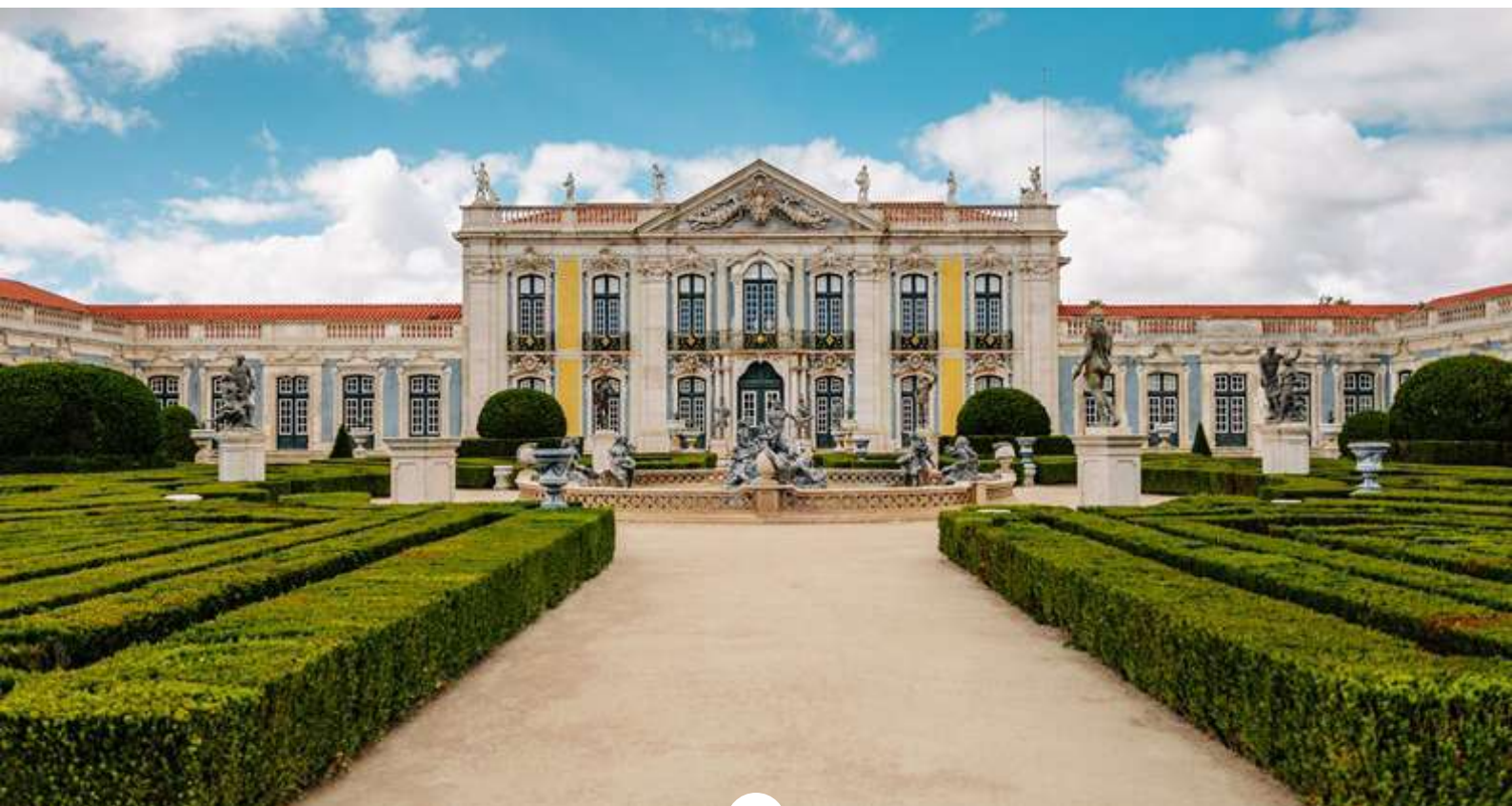

A special place among his works in the Lower Silesia region is occupied by the palace in Kamieniec Ząbkowicki, the Mysłakowice royal palace and Szczytnicki Park in Wrocław. MOUNTAINS OF LITERATURE FESTIVAL

Dates: 13.07 - 20.07.2022

The Mountains of Literature Festival was founded in 2015 at the initiative of writer Olga Tokarczuk, winner of the Nobel Prize for Literature. The festival is a unique literary and social event, its main goals being cultural and civic activation of the public, launching a discussion on environmental protection, equal rights, identity, multinational cultural heritage, transborder cooperation and sustainable development of the Kłodzko Valley through culture.

The 7th edition of the Mountains of Literature Festival in 2022 will take place between 13 and 20 July. The central idea of this year's festival was inspired by Ursula K. Le Guin, who in 1986, in a text entitled "The Carrier Bag Theory of Fiction", referred to the intuition and concepts according to which the memory of humanity's development continually cultivated through the history of creating and using tools of violence – bones, spears, axes, etc. – is an intellectual fraud. According to the writer, the foundation of the origins of civilisation lies in baskets, bags and nets – containers in which we collect useful things, which we then carry home, use ourselves and share with others. Elaborating on that idea, we will notice, apart from its various values and inspirations, the debunking of the still-dominant narrative: shifting the focus of the founding myth of humanity from the Man-Hero to the Human Being-Gatherer. Which also allows for a different look at the stereotype of the woman. The contemptuous, yet still present, image of "a woman with heavy bags" changes its character. It becomes a story about the true beginning and origins of humanity.

This year, the festival will become a huge basket, in which – thanks to authors, artists and academics – the seeds of many ideas which are extremely important in the contemporary world will be gathered and shared with the participants, in an attempt to change the world for the better. More loyal, more equal, more just.

This year's edition features the traditional meetings with authors, concerts, film screenings and exhibitions, but will also focus in particular on debates on the rule of law, freedom of speech, feminism and ecology. Participants will discuss various models of protest, will gather stories of the local residents, diagnose threats and define changes, considering the notion of identity and design the future. Using the example of the Benelux countries, the festival will return to the founding idea of the values of the European Union, in order to talk about coexistence, multiethnicity and multilingualism. The festival will also refer to current events which seem to be spiralling out of control – most of all, the crisis on the Polish-Belarusian border.

Hiking in the mountains, participants will cross the Czech border with botanists and poets, who will speak about nature knowing no borders. As usual, there will be workshops teaching adults to write and young people to read individually and with comprehension. The festival will be crowned by a seminar on surrealism and a multi-genre exhibition of young Polish art.

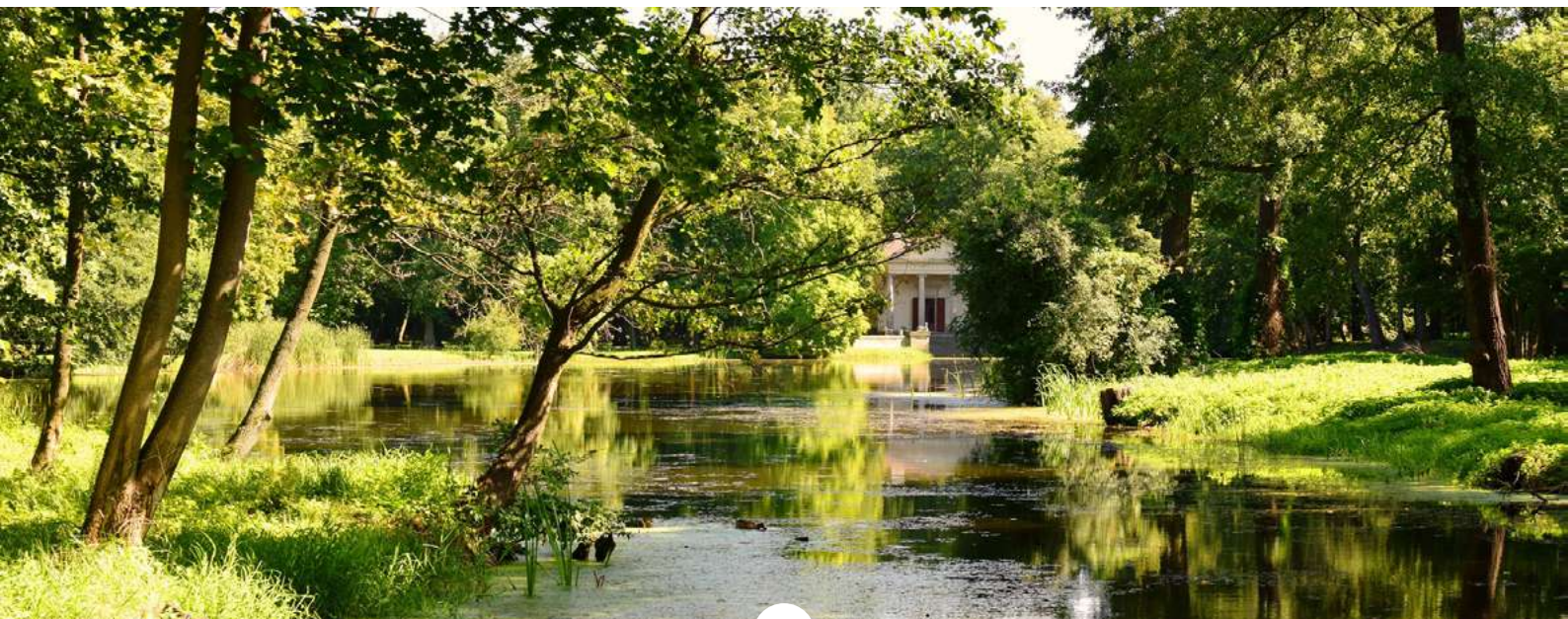

Extreme weather events are becoming more frequent: in some places, too much water can no longer be absorbed by the ground. The consequences are high water and flooding. Elsewhere there is drought and low water.

This has an impact on our life in town and country, on the (supply) security of citizens, on biodiversity, nature and agriculture.

As the largest drinking water reservoir in Baden-Württemberg, Lake Constance plays a special role in times of prolonged dryness and periods of drought. Its water is becoming more and more valuable as climate change progresses.

On July 25, we want to discuss the consequences of climate change for water management in municipalities and regions with experts from research, politics, administration and practice. We would like to deepen the topics of water-sensitive urban development, precaution and risk management with a view to floods and heavy rain as well as water protection measures and water development measures.
